## CALL FOR PAPERS

We are happy to announce that the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference of the International Association for Comparative Mythology is to be held at <u>Rathcroghan Visitor</u> <u>Centre</u>, **Tulsk**, **Ireland** on **August 21-25**, **2023**. The conference is organized by the IACM in collaboration with Rathcroghan Visitor Centre and the Fluid and Complex Systems Research Centre at Coventry University, UK. All members are warmly invited to present papers and to participate in the discussions.

The conference will be held in hybrid format: we will accept papers to be presented either in person or virtually by Zoom.

This year we have the following topics:

- 1. *Violence and War in Mythology and Religion*, including but not limited to the following sub-topics:
  - War in mythology and epics;
  - Deities and mythological characters related to war and violence;
  - Violence vs. non-violence in myth and religion;
  - Enemies and opponents in myth;
  - Myths on violence outside the battlefield;
  - Warriors and weapons;
  - Constructing modern mythological narratives related to war and violence.

## 2. Mythology and Community, including

- Community-defining and community-specific myths;
- Modern communities and old myths;
- Mythology reception and traditions within communities.

- 3. A special topic: *Celtic Mythology*, with a special emphasis on
  - Irish mythology;
  - Ráth Cruachan and the Ulster Cycle mythology;
  - Comparative study of Celtic myths in the context of the Indo-European and World mythology.
- 4. A "free topic", i.e., any other topic you would like to propose/choose for vour paper will be considered.

Please indicate if you would like to present your paper in person or virtually. The abstracts will be reviewed by a selection committee; the selected abstracts will be published on our website (http://www.compmyth.org)

## PAPER LENGTH

Each speaker will be allotted a 30 min. time slot. The expected paper length is 20 minutes plus 10 minutes discussion.

The language of the conference is English.

#### CONFERENCE FORMAT

While the conference will be held in hybrid format, we hope that most participants will be able to come this year in person; however, we will also accept a limited number of papers to be presented virtually by Zoom and will allow virtual participation of the audience. Please note that the conference format is subject to change due to adverse global political, ecological or epidemiological events.

CONFERENCE FEE for the participants from North America, Australia, Northeast Asia, the EU and EEA countries, UK and Switzerland participating in person is €80 (\$88), which will cover the conference dinner and reception. Students from the aforementioned countries and participants from other regions can participate for a reduced fee – €40 (\$44). Virtual participation fee is \$15. Scholars from Ukraine can participate in the conference **free** of charge.

After the conference, we will offer a possibility to participate in excursions to other famous cultural and archaeological sites in Ireland.
